**COUNT 1:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully traffics in marijuana **less than eight (8) ounces, 2<sup>nd</sup> or greater offense** or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possesses a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug; a controlled substance analogue; **methamphetamine (His 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense)**; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers, and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 3:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possess a controlled substance classified in Schedules IV or V or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 4:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County,

Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 5:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 6:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant who has not applied for an operator's license or whose operator's license has been denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked, or whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle upon the highways while the license is denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle is withdrawn, or the license has not been applied for or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 7:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant no person shall: display or cause or permit to be displayed or have in his possession any operator's license knowing it to be fictitious or to have been canceled, revoked, suspended or altered; lend to, or knowingly permit the use of by, one not entitled to, any operator's license issued to the person so lending or permitting the use of the license; represent as one's own any operator's license not issued to the person displaying the license; fail to surrender to the cabinet upon demand, any operator's license which has been

suspended, canceled or revoked; use a false name or give a false address in any application for an operator's license or any renewal or duplicate, or knowingly make a false statement or knowingly conceal a material fact or otherwise commit a fraud in any application or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 8:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant each vehicle towed by a towline shall display the lights required on vehicles of the class to which it belongs; Each vehicle being led by another and connected to it in a manner that will keep them uniformly spaced shall carry at least one (1) light on the left side in such a manner as to show an amber light to the front and a red light to the rear visible at least one thousand (1,000) feet away; When any part of a load projects more than four (4) feet beyond a vehicle, two (2) red flags by day and two (2) red lights during the period provided in KRS 189.030 must be placed upon the extremity of the projection marking the width of the overhang; Any motor vehicle used as a towing unit where two (2) lamps displaying red lights are not obscured by the towed unit or its load may be equipped with two (2) lamps displaying red lights on the towed unit, the towing unit, or both or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 9:**

The Grand Jury charges: that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant No vehicle shall be operated upon any highway unless it is so constructed as to prevent its contents from escaping; No vehicle shall be operated upon any public highway for a distance of over one (1) mile whose load is susceptible to shifting or spillage unless said load is covered with a device suitable for prevention of spillage or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 10:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 11:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to produce written proof in the form of an insurance card that the insured has in effect an insurance contract providing security in conformity with this subtitle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 12:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to have the receipt issued by the cabinet through the county clerk constantly in his possession or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said

act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 13:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 16, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant failed to have the license plate on vehicle to be illuminated when vehicle is being operated or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
