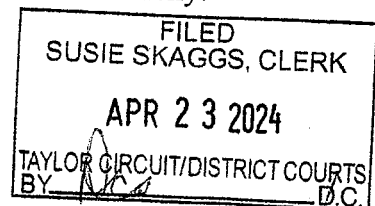

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 21, 2023, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when except as authorized by law he intentionally or wantonly: subjects any animal to or causes cruel or injurious mistreatment through abandonment, participates other than as provided in KRS 525.125 in causing it to fight for pleasure or profit (including, but not limited to being a spectator or vendor at an event where a four (4) legged animal is caused to fight for pleasure or profit), mutilation, beating, torturing any animal other than a dog or cat, tormenting, failing to provide adequate food, drink, space, or health care, or by any other means; subjects any animal in his/her custody to cruel neglect; or kills any animal other than a domestic animal killed by poisoning or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



more of cocaine; Two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine; ten (10) or more dosage units of a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug, or a controlled substance analogue; an quantity of fentanyl, carfentanil, or fentanyl derivatives; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers or any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraph (a) (b) or (c) of this subsection in an amount less than the amounts specified in those paragraphs or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about October 14, 2023, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant drops or permits to drop on a highway any destructive or injurious material and does not immediately remove it; or Knowingly places or throws litter on any public or private property or in any public or private water without permission; or Negligently places or throws glass or other dangerous pointed or edged substances on or adjacent to water to which the public has access for swimming or wading or on or within fifty (50) feet of a public highway; or discharges sewage, mineral, oil products, or litter into any public waters or lakes within the state or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act.
