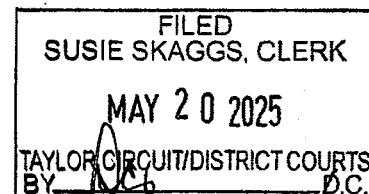

COUNT 1:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about December 27, 2024 through December 28, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant engages in sexual intercourse with another person who is incapable of consent because he or she is an individual with an intellectual disability; being 21 years old or more he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than sixteen (16) years old (**KR**); Being at least ten (10) years old or older than a person who is sixteen(16) or seventeen (17) years old at the time of sexual intercourse, he or she engages in sexual intercourse, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with the person; being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with another person less than eighteen (18) years old and for whom he or she provides a foster family home as defined in KRS 600.020; being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust, as defined in KRS 532.045, he or she engages in sexual intercourse with a minor under eighteen (18) years old with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of that position; being a jailer or an employee, contractor, vendor, or volunteer of the Department of Corrections Department of Juvenile Justice, or a detention facility for the custody, supervision, evaluation, or treatment of offenders, he or she subjects a person who he or she knows is incarcerated, supervised, evaluated, or treated by the Department of Corrections, Department of Juvenile Justice, detention facility, or contracting entity, to sexual intercourse or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



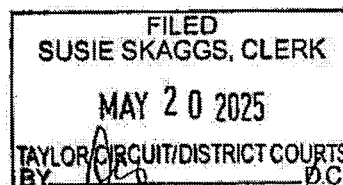

The Grand Jury charges that on or about April 10, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant possessed, manufactured or transported a handgun when he has been convicted of a felony as defined by the laws of the jurisdiction in which he was convicted, in any state of federal court and has not: been granted a full pardon by the Governor or by the President of the United States; Been granted relief by the United States Secretary of the Treasury pursuant to the Federal Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about April 10, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia while in possession of handgun or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 10, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed marijuana while in possession of a handgun or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about April 10, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 10, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to wear a seat belt while operating a motor vehicle upon the roadway or aided, abetted, or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to comply with sex offender registration when he did not notify Probation and Parole by completing and returning the address verification letter or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant took or exercised control over movable property of another with intent to deprive him thereof; or obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about April 11, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant who has not applied for an operator's license or whose operator's license has been denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked, or whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle upon the highways while the license is denied, canceled, suspended, or revoked or his privilege to operate a motor vehicle is withdrawn, or the license has not been applied for or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



COUNTS 3-4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 7, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally caused serious physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument or under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life he/she wantonly engaged in conduct which creates a grave risk of death to another and thereby causes serious physical injury to another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 7, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant while operating a motor vehicle with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys a direction to stop his or her motor vehicle, given by a person recognized to be a police officer and at least (1) of the following conditions exists: the person is fleeing immediately after committing an act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720 the person is driving under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or combination of substance in violation of KRS 189A.010; the person is driving while his or her driver's license is suspended for violating KRS 189A.010; or be fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause, or creates substantial risk, of serious physical injury or death of any person or property; as a **pedestrian**, and with intent to elude or flee, the person knowingly or wantonly disobeys and order to stop, given by a person recognized to be a peace officer, and at least one (1) of the following conditions exists: The person fleeing immediately after committing an act of domestic violence as defined in KRS 403.720; or by fleeing or eluding, the person is the cause of serious physical injury or death to any person or property or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 7, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:


The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 7, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof: engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. 

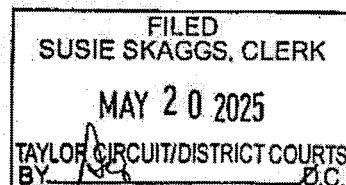

Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
