The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 12, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully was trafficking in Four (4) grams or more of cocaine; Two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine; ten (10) or more dosage units of a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug, or a controlled substance analogue; an quantity of heroin, fentanyl, carfentanil, or fentanyl derivatives; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers or any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraph (a) (b) or (c) of this subsection in an amount less than the amounts specified in those paragraphs or

aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 2:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 12, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 3:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 12, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 4:**

The Grand Jury charges that on or about November 12, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant to whom or for whose use any controlled substance has been prescribed, sold or dispensed, by a practitioner or other person authorized under this chapter, may lawfully possess it only in the container in which it was delivered to him/her by the person selling or dispensing the same or abetted or counseled with another in commission of said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

**COUNT 5:**

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about November 12, 2025, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle upon the highway carelessly or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity


